#### Reception

#### Post

#### **Bed size**

- One-bed flat: single bed 4'0"x6'3" (122cm x 190.5cm)
- Two-bed flat (one double bed): 4'6"x6'3" (137cm x 190.5cm) and two singles 3'0"x6'3" (91.5cm x 190.5cm)

Each room contains bed, desk, chair, shelves, wardrobe and rubbish bins. There is also storage under the bed.
