Reception

Reception can be found at Sherfield Hall.

Post

Postboxes are located in the Sherfield JCR next to Reception. Collect parcels and registered mail from Reception between 08:30–09:30 and 14:00–18:30.

Lift access

No lift. Rooms arranged over two to three floors.

Social facilities

Sherfield JCR. Allocated study space is Sherfield JCR/ Common Room.

Special requirements

Quiet Lifestyle and single-sex areas are available in this hall.

Meal Plan?

The University recommends all first year students enrol onto a Meal Plan. If you haven't already, you can enrol onto a fixed price Meal Plan, ranging from 3 to 21 meals per week, by visiting **www.clever-cuisine.com**. The closest catering outlet is St Patrick's Dining Hall.

Your kitchen

Each Kitchen is equipped with fridge/freezer, kettle, toasters, microwave, hob and oven and is shared between eight residents. Each resident has one kitchen, fridge and freezer shelf.

Do I need induction pans?

No. Sherfield Hall has standard electric ovens and hobs. You do not need a particular type of pan. If purchasing a kitchen pack, please select 'standard hob kitchen pack'.

Walking distance

15 minutes to central Whiteknights Campus.

Nearest public transport

Christchurch Road: 5 minutes Bus: 21 or 21a

Bed size

- En-suite: single bed, 3'0"x6'3" (91.5cm x 190.5cm)
- Standard room with shared bathroom (limited number): 3'0"x6'3" (91.5cm x 190.5cm)

Each room contains bed, desk, chair, shelves, wardrobe and rubbish bin.

Bedding packs and mattress toppers are available to purchase online or from your local reception.

En-suite bathrooms have a toilet, sink, washbasin and shower with a tray/curtain and a fixed showerhead.

Shared bathrooms are unisex, unless in single-sex areas.
